RESOLUTION NO. 2212

RESOLUTION REQUESTING PUTNAM COUNTY AUDITOR CERTIFY TO THE VILLAGE OF GLANDORF TOTAL CURRENT TAX VALUATION AND DOLLAR AMOUNT OF REVENUE THAT WOULD BE GENERATED BY TAX LEVY

WHEREAS, the Village of Glandorf, Ohio, for the purpose of paying for general current expenses under ORC 5705.19(A) has a renewal tax levy that will expire at the end of the 2023 tax year;

WHEREAS, the Village of Glandorf Council upon due consideration and believing it to be in the best interest of the Village, desires to place a tax levy before the electors on the ballot at the November 7, 2023 election as a renewal of the existing levy; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 5705.03 it is necessary to formally request the Putnam County Auditor, of Putnam County, Ohio, certify to the Village of Glandorf the current tax valuation of said Village and dollar amount of revenue that would be generated by the 2.300 mill levy.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY UNANIMOUS CONSENT OF THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF GLANDORF, PUTNAM COUNTY, OHIO:

SECTION 1. That pursuant to this Resolution, Council formally requests the Putnam County Auditor certify to the Village the total current tax valuation of said Village of Glandorf.


SECTION 2. That pursuant to this Resolution, Council formally requests the Putnam County Auditor certify to the Village the dollar amount that would be generated by a 2.300 mill renewal levy for five years (tax years 2024, 2025, 2026, 2027, 2028) commencing January 1, 2024.

SECTION 3. That this tax levy would be placed on the ballot at the November 7, 2023 election and would be due beginning in 2024.


SECTION 4. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the inhabitants of the Village of Glandorf, Ohio and shall be deemed effective at the earliest date allowed under the law.
