RESOLUTION NO. 2248

A RESOLUTION TO ACCEPT THE FY2024 ASSISTANCE TO FIREFIGHTER GRANT AND TO EXECUTE CONTRACTS AS REQUIRED

WHEREAS, the Village of Glandorf has been awarded grant funds from the U.S. Department of Homeland Security, in the amount of \$136,666.66 in federal funding. As a condition of this grant, the village must contribute an amount greater than or equal to \$6,833.34 (5%) of the federal funds awarded for a total approved budget of \$143,500; and

WHEREAS, the grant funds must be used for the purchase of equipment in accordance with the terms and conditions set forth in the Grant Agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF GLANDORF, PUTNAM COUNTY, OHIO, THAT;

SECTION I. This council finds and determines that it is in the best interest of the Village of Glandorf to accept the FY2024 Assistance to Firefighter Grant and execute a Grant Agreement with the U.S. Department of Homeland Security in order for the Village to obtain such grants and to take such further action as necessary to secure such grants.

SECTION II. This council formally approves the acceptance of the grant award in the amount of \$136,666.66 to be used for the purpose set forth in the application of said Grant Agreement.

SECTION III. This council acknowledges and approves that per the terms of the Grant Agreement, the village must contribute an amount greater than or equal to \$6,833.34 (5%) of the federal funds awarded.

SECTION IIII. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning or relating to the passage of this Resolution were passed in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.


SECTION IV. That this Resolution shall be in full force and effective immediately upon passage.
