RESOLUTION NO. 2262

A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE PUTNAM COUNTY 2026 HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN

Whereas, the VILLAGE OF GLANDORF, Putnam County, Ohio is vulnerable to natural and human-caused hazards which may result in loss of life and property, economic hardship, and threats to public health and safety, and

Whereas, Section 322 of the Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000 (DMA 2000) requires state and local governments to develop and submit for approval to the President a mitigation plan that outlines processes for identifying their respective natural hazards, risks, and vulnerabilities, and

Whereas, the VILLAGE OF GLANDORF, acknowledges the requirements of Section 322 of DMA 2000 to have an approved Hazard Mitigation Plan as a prerequisite to receiving post-disaster Hazard Mitigation Grant Program funds, and

Whereas, the Putnam County 2026 Hazard Mitigation Plan has been developed by the Putnam County Office of Public Safety in cooperation with other county departments, the VILLAGE OF GLANDORF officials, institutional stakeholders, and citizens of the Putnam County, and

Whereas, a public involvement process consistent with the requirements of DMA 2000 was conducted to develop the Putnam County 2026 Hazard Mitigation Plan, and

Whereas, the Putnam County 2026 Hazard Mitigation Plan recommends mitigation activities that will reduce losses to life and property affected by both natural and human-caused hazards that face the county and its city and village governments,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the governing body for the VILLAGE OF GLANDORF:

Section 1. THAT, the Putnam County 2026 Hazard Mitigation Plan is hereby adopted as the official Hazard Mitigation Plan of the VILLAGE OF GLANDORF and


Section 2. THAT, the respective officials and agencies identified in the implementation strategy of the Putnam County 2026 Hazard Mitigation Plan are hereby directed to implement the recommended activities assigned to them.
